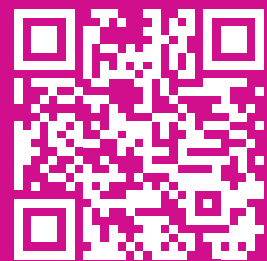
Faith in Action
